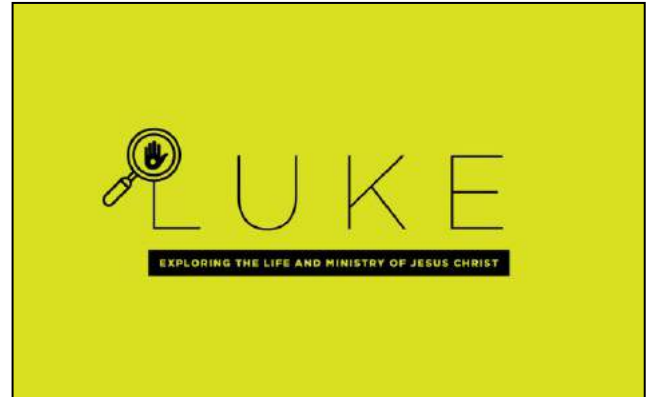
Pastor James is our speaker this morning

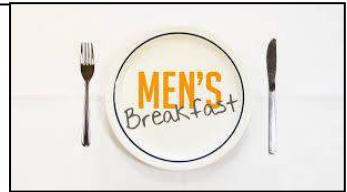

EVERYONE wishing to help **must** attend the **Planning and Training Evening on Thursday 9th February, 7.30pm.**

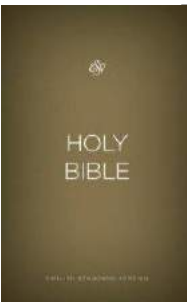
