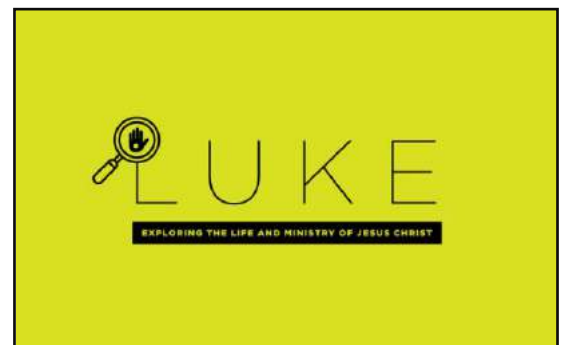
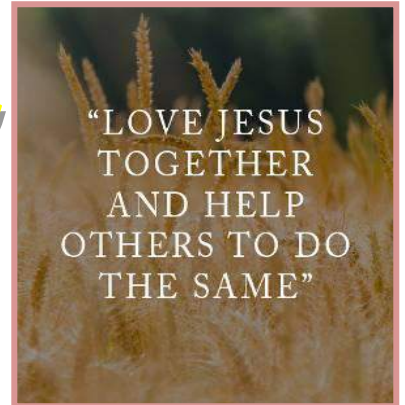
Welcome to Church today!

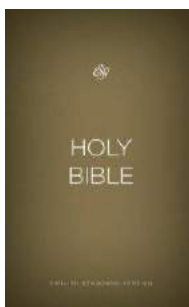
Many thanks to all those who attended the **Safeguarding training evening** on Tuesday – it was encouraging to see everyone so positive about this important matter.
