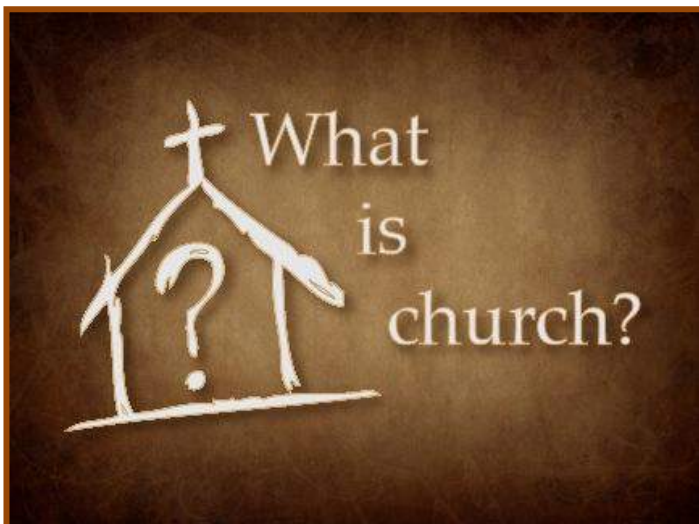


Pastor James is our
