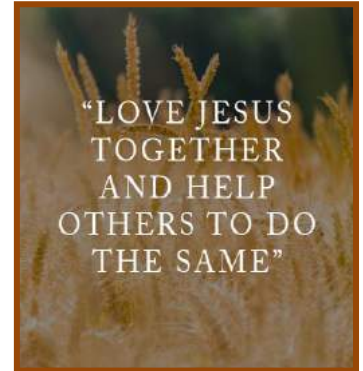


Pastor James is our speaker this morning

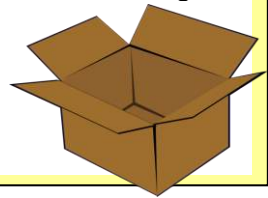
