

This is open to all at BRBC who work with children and young people, and to anyone who is interested in doing this in the future.

Suezie Howard made Bran Muffins at CHAOS and several of you have asked for the recipe. Suezie kindly shares it with us below.....

Easy Bran Muffins

2 cups bran flakes (crushed)

½ cup oil

2 eggs

¾ cup sugar

½ cup milk

(mix all of these 5 ingredients and soak for 5 minutes)

1 ½ cups plain flour

2 level teaspoons baking powder

¼ teaspoon salt

(add mixed dry ingredients to wet)

1 – 2 over-ripe mashed bananas (optional) stirred through just before filling cases

Muffins don't like to be over mixed so mix until just until combined.

Spoon into preferred size muffin cases – 12 regular or 24 mini

Bake at 160 – 180 until golden (approx 15 – 20 minutes)

Serve warm from oven, split and buttered. (They freeze well)
