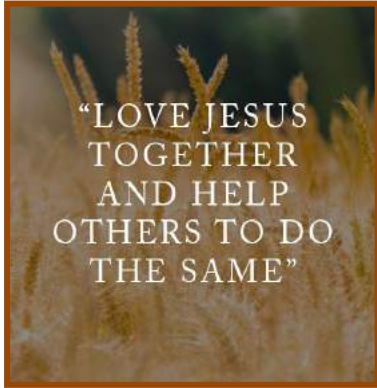

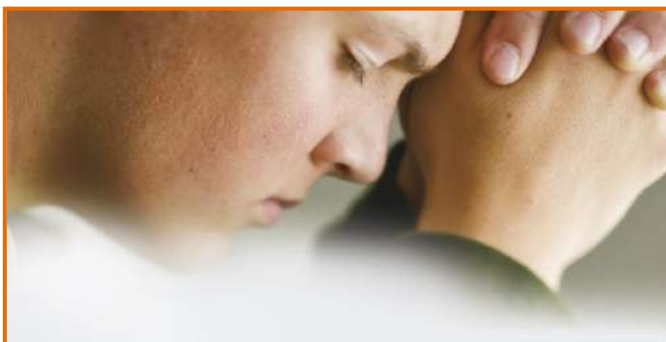
Welcome to Church today!
