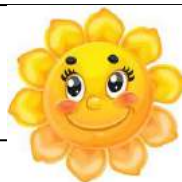


"Standing for Christ in the public square"

(Caring for Life is a Christian charity in Leeds which cares for homeless & disadvantaged people in the City)



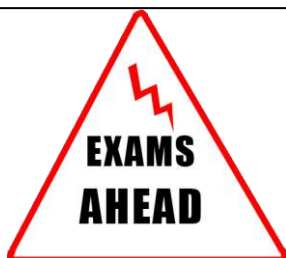
