This morning we'll study Luke 19 and read about Jesus giving a parable as he made his way towards, and then read about his Triumphal Entry as he entered into, Jerusalem.

The overarching point of all this is to simply say that Jesus is King. But if we're honest, it's really easy for us to mentally and verbally subscribe to that truth, and miss the fact that it's a whole other matter to actually live into it. It's one thing to say Jesus is king over us, but another thing to live out.

This morning we'll see what kind of king Jesus is and then examine ourselves to ask, "Is Jesus really that kind of king to me?"

David was once described as "a man after God's own heart".
