


Pastor James is

It's our last study in Luke's Gospel for some time. After today, we'll not get back into Luke until we begin our Easter series, as we walk with Jesus through his final few days. But today, we'll see yet another dynamic of what Luke has been hammering away at since he began: **Jesus is God.** Through Luke's account of the Sadducees' questioning, the Scribes' rituals, and the widow's offering, we'll come face to face with the stunning reality that, **because Jesus is God, He sees everything.**

The foundation for all Christian faith and teaching – and the source of all meaning in life – can be found in the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. Alistair Begg draws these truths from a key passage in 1 Corinthians 15 and explains how the good news of the Gospel must include both a dying Saviour and a risen, living Lord. Our understanding of Jesus' resurrection forms the basis from which we each answer two important questions: Do I believe in Jesus? And, Do I belong to Him?


