Morning: Luke - "You Say That I Am" **Speaker: Pastor James / Luke 22:66-23:17**

In the lead up to Easter we've been following Jesus' final few hours before his crucifixion. This week, from Luke 22-23, we'll see Jesus stand before three distinct authorities. Each authority is presented with the claim of Jesus' kingship and each one refuses to accept it or face the implications of it. Let's explore each revealing reaction and see how these speak into our lives.

The apostle Paul said: "So we do not lose heart" (2 Corinthians 4:16). Easier said than done?
