





Morning: Wrestling with God
Speaker: Pastor James / Genesis 32

Evening: One Thing
Speaker: David Stannard/Luke 10:38-42

Jacob is the recipient of God's promise - he belongs to God, but that doesn't mean there is not work to be done. This morning we'll explore a defining moment in Jacob's life. It's a moment that shows us how God has been shaping him into the kind of character who can carry the promise. Let's dive into Genesis 32 to see how God forms, refines and grows His people.

How important is it to stop and consider the way we are living? In the 21st century, it is so easy to be driven by the necessary demands rather than to evaluate whom we are serving. In this passage, Jesus recognises where Martha is and seeks to free her from this slavery.



Mens' Bowling Night


