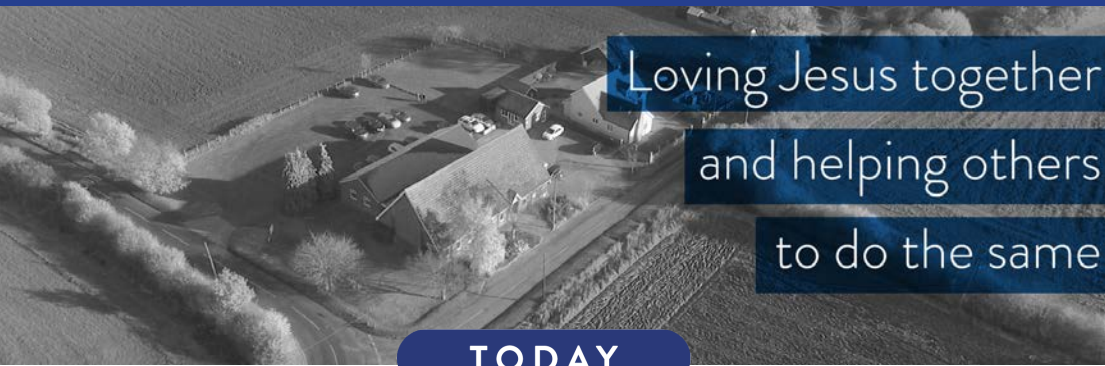

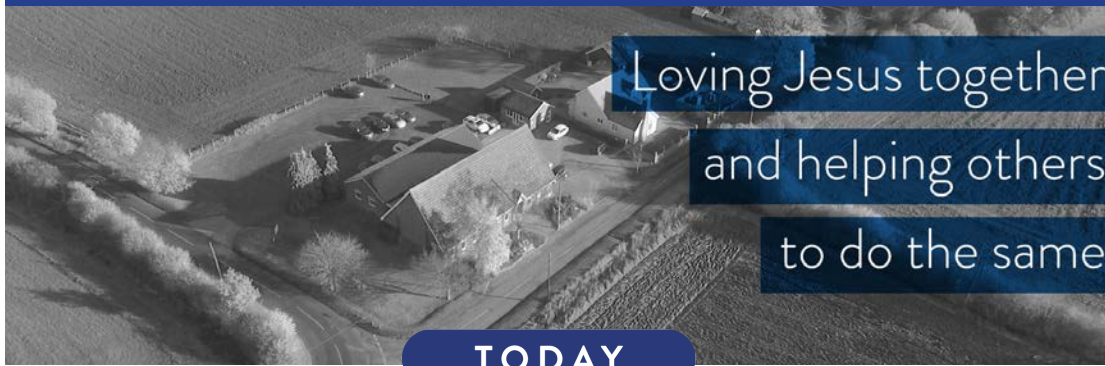
Morning: The Heart
